NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Kirby Road Extension between Bathurst Street and Dufferin Street in City of Vaughan

Rizmi Holdings Limited (RHL) and the City of Vaughan, following City of Vaughan Council authorization in June 2019, provide Notice as co-proponents that the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study (EA Study) for the extension of Kirby Road between Bathurst Street and Dufferin Street in the City of Vaughan is complete.

The EA Study was conducted as a Schedule 'C' Municipal Road Project in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015.



The EA Study builds on findings of the City of Vaughan Transportation Master Plan (2012), the Regional Municipality of York Transportation Master Plan (2016) and the North Vaughan and New Communities Transportation Master Plan (2019) and advances implementation of the extension of the Kirby Road missing link section between Bathurst Street and Dufferin Street in north Vaughan. The planned road extension is shown on the map to the left in green color.

The EA planning and design process included: consultation with public and review agencies; screening and evaluation of alternative road alignments and design concepts; and, assessment and mitigation of potential effects of the Kirby Road Extension on the environment.

The Environmental Study Report (ESR) documents the EA Study process and identifies the preliminary preferred design establishing a new urban multi-modal arterial road extension between Bathurst Street and Dufferin Street which is featuring: four vehicular general purpose lanes (two in each direction) and auxiliary lanes at intersections (existing and future) accommodating public transit, cars and trucks; active transportation facilities on both sides of the road for pedestrians and cyclists with provision and opportunity for separated cycling facility; structured culvert crossing of the tributary to East Patterson Creek; and, north-south underpass crossings at two locations providing opportunities for trail connectivity.
