Hanlan Road Area- Road Rehabilitation and Watermain Replacement

August 18, 2017

In early spring 2018, the City of Vaughan is planning to undertake work to improve the existing road and watermain infrastructures on Hanlan Road Area.

PLANNED WORK

During the remaining months in 2017, City will be undertaking investigation activities for the project which includes topographic and/or legal surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation works. The various underground utilities (i.e. Gas, Bell and Hydro) will be marked out using different colours of paint.

Newsletter(s) providing additional details on the project as well as the construction timelines will be issued prior to commencement of construction in March 2018.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACT ON RESIDENTS AND TRAFFIC

All roads will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out by either City staff or a City approved consultant, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery Department.

Property owners are reminded that underground systems such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways and electrical conduits etc. may be within the City-owned boulevard or property limits and may be impacted by the proposed construction work. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items that are within the City-owned boulevard or property limits (Encroachment By-law no. 244-2005).

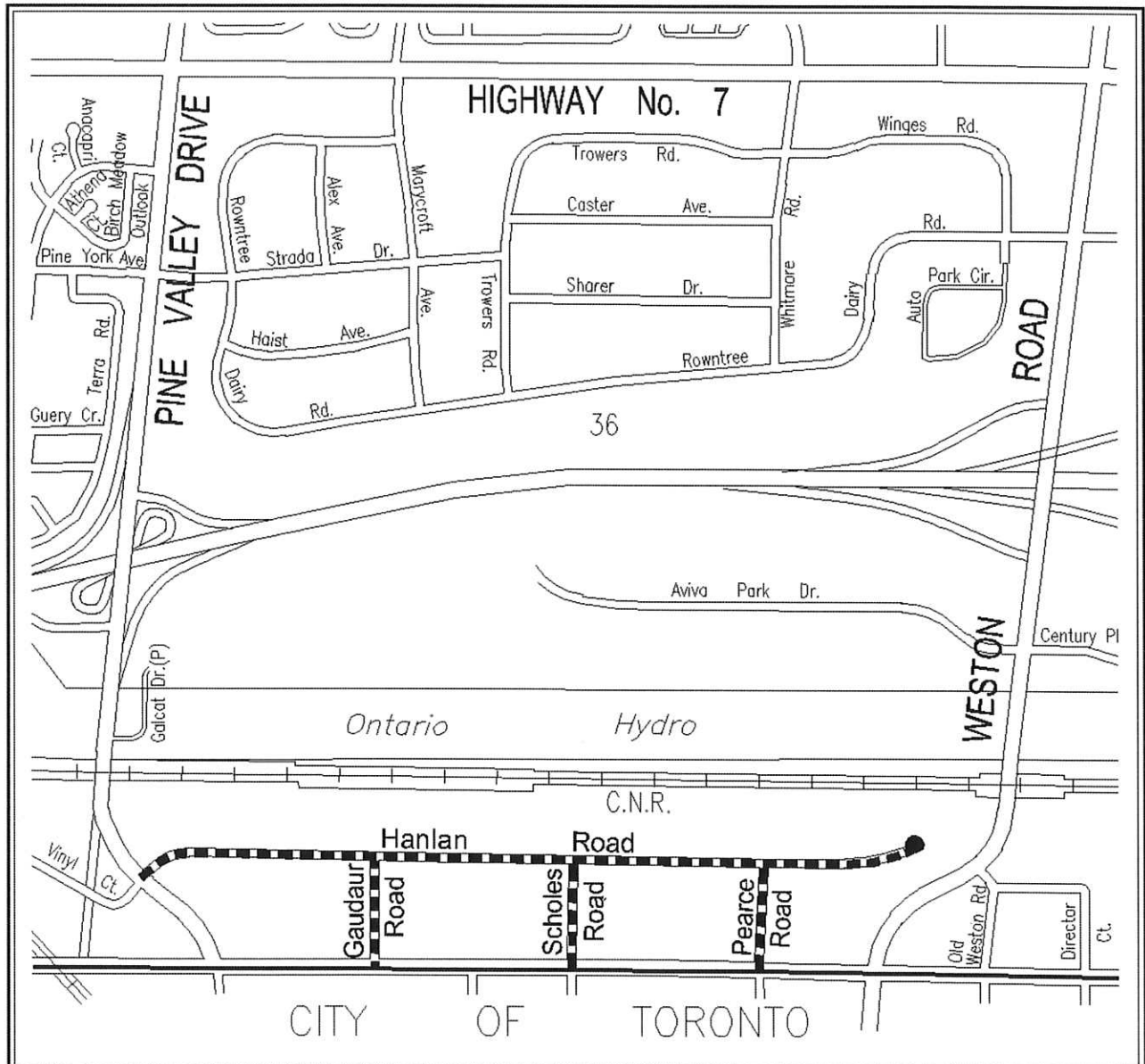
