BY-LAW NUMBER 87-95

A By-Law to partially assume Municipal Services in the Woodbridge Meadows - Phase I, Registered Plan 65M-2857 \setminus 19T-88009, and to authorize execution of an amendment to the Subdivision Agreement.

Whereas the Subdivision Agreement between the City of Vaughan and Highway 27 - Langstaff Holdings Inc. provides for the installation of certain public services.

AND WHEREAS the Director of Engineering has certified that the services in Registered Plan 65M-2857, except for the storm detention facility have been constructed and installed in accordance with City Specifications.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the services in Registered Plan 65M-2857 more particularly described in the Subdivision Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Vaughan and Highway 27 Langstaff Holdings Inc. dated December 18, 1990, with the exception of the storm detention facility described in the Subdivision Agreement, be and they are hereby assumed as public services.
- 2. AND THAT this By-Law shall take effect upon the day of receipt by the City Treasurer of the required payment for the Langstaff watermain, the sidewalk and streetlighting on Highway #27 and the Rainbow Creek drainage works as described in the Subdivision Agreement and the outstanding tax arrears up to the date of payment, and upon execution of an amendment to the Subdivision Agreement to indemnify the City during the maintenance period for the repaired deficiencies.
- AND THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the
 Amending Agreement as set out in Section 2, above.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed this 20th day of March, 1995.
