Swimming Instructors are vital in developing the important life skills of swimming. They create an enjoyable environment for all people of all ages and abilities while focusing on safety.

Prerequisites: Must be 16 years of age or older; must have current Lifesaving Society and Red Cross Instructor awards; LSS Standard First Aid, CPR-C; Bronze Cross or NLS.

Consideration for either of these positions consists of a 'wet' and 'dry' interview.

Applicants are required to bring bathing suits for the the 'wet' interview. Candidates may be asked to perform NLS skills and teach a short instructional lesson. A 'dry' interview will be arranged upon successful completion of the 'wet' interview.

Lifeguards are more than good swimmers. They are water rescue professionals trained in emergency care. They prevent accidents, identify hazards and determine safe practices. Lifeguarding is a fun, exciting and rewarding job. It carries an enormous responsibility, which is why lifeguards take continuous training to ensure their skills, knowledge and fitness remain sharp.

Prerequisites: Must be 16 years of age or older; must have current NLS certificate; AED and LSS Standard First Aid.
