York Region H1N1 Clinics not accepting further patients today to accommodate existing lineups

Three to four-hour wait times at clinics in City of Vaughan and Town of Newmarket

NEWMARKET – As of 4 p.m. today, Wednesday, October 28th, lineups have now been closed at the two current H1N1 vaccination clinics to allow people currently in line to be vaccinated between now and 8 p.m. when the clinics will close for the evening.

The patients currently in line at each clinic as of 4 p.m. today will receive their H1N1 vaccination.
