The final property tax bills for residential, farmland, managed forest and pipeline properties were mailed on **JUNE 29, 2010**.

### DUE DATES:

1st Installment	Thursday, July 22, 2010
2nd Installment	Monday, August 23, 2010
3rd Installment	Tuesday, September 21, 2010

**PAYMENTS:** Payments may be made by pre-authorized payment, post-dated cheques, through financial institutions, computer or telephone banking, Interac payments, mail, and at the Civic Centre.

**DIDN'T RECEIVE A BILL?** Non receipt of a tax bill does not waive your obligation to pay and you may incur a penalty. *If you did not receive a bill, call the Tax Department as soon as possible at 905-832-8502.*

## OUTDOOR WATER RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

From May 15 to September 30 each year, the outdoor use of water is restricted to ensure there is an adequate supply of water for fire protection and personal consumption.

During this time period, lawn watering, filling of pools, washing of cars, etc. is restricted as follows:

**ODD HOUSE NUMBERS** can only use outdoor water on **odd calendar days** 6 am. to 9 am; and, 6 pm to 9 pm.

**EVEN HOUSE NUMBERS** can only use outdoor water on **even calendar days** 6 am to 9 am; and, 6 pm to 9 pm.

**Industrial/Commercial/Institutional** properties are restricted to watering for a maximum period of 3 hours, 12:00 am to 7 am.

Should a "Water Advisory" be issued, all residents will be asked to **voluntarily** refrain from any outdoor water use.

In all cases, freshly laid sod and newly planted shrubs and trees are exempt from such restrictions for a 4-week period.

#### Please remember:

1. Leaf and yard waste material set out for collection must be in Kraft paper bags or open top rigid containers (labeled leaf and yard waste).
2. Branches must be tied in secure bundles no longer than 1.5m (5 ft.) in length and individual branches must not exceed 10 cm (4 in.) in diameter.
