WEEKLY FALL LEAF AND YARD COLLECTION

OCTOBER 11 to DECEMBER 2

Weekly Fall Leaf and Yard Collection program begins **October 11** and ends **December 2**. Yard waste is collected **EVERY WEEK** during this period on your regular collection day.

- Place yard waste at curbside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the evening prior and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the day of collection.
- Yard waste is collected only if placed in proper containers. Acceptable containers are kraft paper bags or open top rigid containers (i.e. a regulation sized garbage container) clearly marked "leaf and yard waste". *Yard waste placed in other types of containers will not be collected.*
- Branches must be tied in secure bundles no longer than 1.5m (5 ft.) and not exceeding 0.9m (3 ft.) in any other dimension.
- Total weight of any full container shall not exceed 20 kg. (45 lbs.)
- If you employ landscapers or gardeners, it is your responsibility to inform them of the City's curbside collection requirements.

The amendment proposes to re-designate the easterly (9 ha) portion of the lands within the proposed Vaughan Healthcare Campus Centre site, from "Special Study Area" designation to "Hospital Precinct Plan" designation, bringing the entire site under one designation requirement as set out in OPA No. 715.

The "Hospital Precinct Plan" designation sets out planning steps and analyses that will be required prior to the development of a healthcare campus and affiliated uses.

2011 WATERMAIN PROTECTION PROGRAM

CAST IRON AND DUCTILE IRON PIPES



In an effort to preserve the integrity of the City's older cast iron and ductile iron water distribution mains, the Public Works Department will be continuing its watermain protection program. This work will take place in numerous locations throughout the City over the next three months affecting the Concord, Maple and Woodbridge areas.

This work involves using a vacuum truck to excavate a small hole in the boulevard area or on the road to provide access to the watermain. Once accessible, a sacrificial anode, which is encased in a cardboard tube, is welded to the iron watermain. The anodes are designed to corrode instead of the watermain, thereby extending the useful life and structural integrity of the pipe.

The City of Vaughan is conducting studies to direct the ongoing development of the City's urban water infrastructure systems that support our communities. These systems include water distribution, wastewater collection and storm water management.

These studies are following the Municipal Servicing Master Plan Class Environmental Assessment (MPCEA) process and will support the City's new Official Plan which was adopted by Council in September 2010. The studies will consider the vision for Vaughan to the year 2031 with sustainability as a key underlying theme.

MASTER PLAN CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The City has awarded contracts for the following Master Plan studies to be undertaken concurrently:

- City-Wide Storm Drainage/Storm Water Management Master Plan (Cole Engineering Group Limited); and
- City-Wide Water/Wastewater Master Plan (The Municipal Infrastructure Group Ltd. and Fabian Papa & Partners Inc.).

PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE DETAILS

A joint public information centre (PIC) has been scheduled to present the process that is being employed for the studies, and to identify the existing conditions, needs, and justification. The PIC will provide stakeholders with an opportunity to review and comment on the study information. Public comment obtained at the PIC will be incorporated into the next phase of the study, which is the selection of the preferred solutions for water servicing, wastewater servicing, and stormwater management.

GREENING VAUGHAN TIPS



GRAPE AND TOMATO SKINS is to be placed inside your green bin for collection. Should you have excess material, please double bag your compostable bag and place on top of/beside your green bin.



Remember – any one item set out for collection cannot exceed 20.5 kg (45 lbs).



WOODEN (GRAPE) CRATES are considered garbage. To ensure collection, please break down and bundle wooden crates and remove (or hammer down) all nails/staples. Remember, each bundle will count as an item toward Vaughan's 3-item garbage limit. Any garbage item exceeding the 3-item limit will require a paid garbage tag. **Do not stack crates together or fill crates with grape skins.**
