PINE VALLEY DRIVE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ENHANCEMENT INCLUDING HEADWALL AND SPILLWAY REHABILITATION

The City of Vaughan is proposing to rehabilitate an existing concrete headwall storm outlet and spillway located on the west side of Pine Valley Drive at Clubhouse Road in Woodbridge. The force of the stormwater flows at the outlet has eroded and scoured the spillway and has undermined the concrete headwall. Downstream of the headwall there has been significant erosion of the drainage swale which runs through approximately 250 metres of environmentally sensitive forested area of Boyd Park, which is owned by the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority.

As part of this assignment, the Consulting Engineer will be required to identify the upstream drainage area and calculate flows based on various storm events to this outlet. The Consultant shall determine various options to incorporate industry standard storm water management solutions for the drainage area identified, as well as present options to restore the concrete headwall and the eroded drainage swale through Boyd Park.

The City of Vaughan may also require the services to prepare engineering designs and tender documents based on the preferred options and if required, to provide construction administration services during construction.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Christmas trees are collected during the weeks of January 10 and 17, on your regular collection day.

Reminders:

- Cut trees larger than 2.13 m (7 ft.) in half, as they cannot fit into our collection vehicles.

- Remove all tinsel, ornaments, plastic bags and tree stands.

- Ensure tree is accessible for collection. Christmas trees buried in the snow or placed on top of or behind snowbanks may not be collected.

DOUBLE UP DAY EVENT

The City's 'Double up Day' events provide an opportunity for you to dispose up to 6 items of garbage without the need of paid garbage tags.

- If you live in a **YELLOW ZONE**, your Double-Up Day is during the week of **January 10**.

- If you live in a **BLUE ZONE**, your Double-Up Day is during the week of **January 17**.

During this event, garbage tags are only required if you have **7 or more items**. The City will collect a maximum of 13 garbage items per designated collection day.

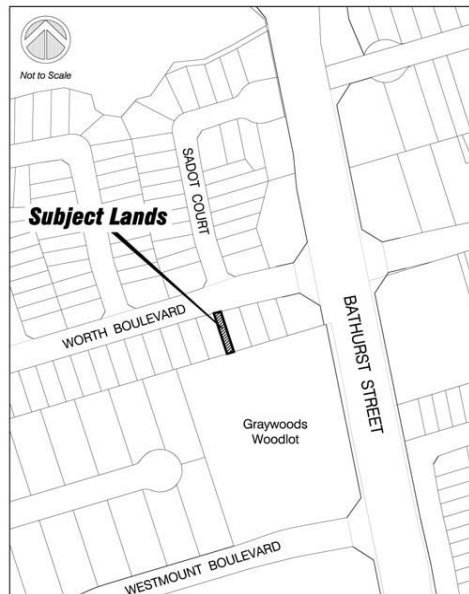
