The purpose of the meeting is to amend Zoning By-law 1-88 by amending the maximum building height requirements of Schedules "A" and "A2" of By-law 1-88, by establishing a 5 storey (16.5 metre) minimum building height limit in the areas designated "Corporate Centre Corridor", "Corporate Centre Node" and a small portion of lands designated "Corporate Centre District", in the Vaughan Corporate Centre.

## Winter Waste Placement

**SNOWBANKS:** Please ensure your blue boxes, green bins and garbage items are at the curb (i.e. on or beside your driveway) on your designated collection day. Do not place your materials on top of or behind snow banks as it can be difficult for collection crews to access, and may cause materials to spill onto the roadway.

**SET BACK FROM ROAD:** During heavy snowfalls, garbage, blue boxes, and green bin materials must be set back from the curb approximately 0.9 metres (3 ft.) and placed on the right side of the driveway (the side that is on the right when facing the house). This set out requirement helps prevent waste materials from being knocked over or buried by snow ploughing operations.
