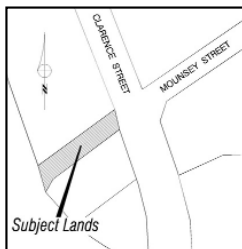

Notice To Property Owners

Notice is given to every person in possession of land within the City of Vaughan that all noxious weed or weed seeds will be destroyed by **JUNE 1, 2009**. Throughout the season, the municipality in accordance with the Weed Control Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990 Chapter W5 Section 3, 16, 22 and 23, may enter upon said land to cause the noxious weeds or weed seeds to be destroyed. This will be charged to said lands; if not paid, will be placed on property owners' taxes.

In the interest of public health, noxious weeds that require eradication are thistles, ragweed, goats beard, poison ivy, wild carrot, etc. Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds within the City, therefore, complaints regarding these weeds cannot be accepted. However, the cooperation of all citizens is solicited in the elimination of all nuisance weeds. Vaughan now bans the use of chemicals to destroy weeds or weed seeds.
