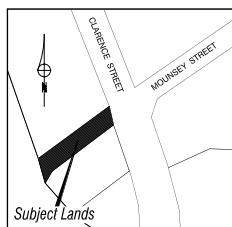
This year's SUMMER leaf and yard waste collection program **STARTS JUNE 2**. Leaf and yard waste is collected **EVERY OTHER WEEK** on your regular garbage collection day. To identify your proper collection week please reference your current collection schedule/reference guide or refer to [www.greeningvaughan.ca](http://www.greeningvaughan.ca).

- Leaf and yard waste material set out for collection must be in Kraft paper bags or open top rigid containers (labeled leaf and yard waste).
- Branches must be tied in secure bundles no longer than 1.5m (5 ft.) in length and individual branches must not exceed 10 cm (4") in diameter.

**FREE MULCH, AND TRUCKLOAD SALE OF**  
**GREEN BINS, BLUE BOXES & COMPOSTERS**

Residents are requested to bring containers  
or bags to transport their mulch.

The City's Parks and Forestry Operations has an extensive mulching program using recycled material from tree cuttings and removals. In an ongoing effort to enhance the longevity of trees, residents are encouraged to apply mulch around their trees as well. Residents are invited to attend one of Vaughan's environment days, running from **10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on:**

\* NOTE: Mulch must remain within the boundaries for residents residing in the ALHB regulated area. The CFIA have identified the ALHB regulated area to be delineated by Hwy 27 to the West, Rutherford Road to the North, Dufferin Street to the East, and Steeles Avenue to the South.

**NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS**  
**TO DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS**

Notice is hereby given to every person in possession of land within the City of Vaughan that all noxious weed or weed seeds shall be destroyed by **June 1, 2009**. Throughout the season the municipality, in accordance with the Weed Control Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990 Chapter W5 Section 3, 16, 22 and 23, may enter upon said land to cause the noxious weeds or weed seeds to be destroyed. This will be charged to said lands; if not paid, will be placed on property owners' taxes.

In the interest of public health, noxious weeds that require eradication are thistles, ragweed, goats beard, poison ivy, wild carrot, etc. Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds within the City of Vaughan, therefore, complaints regarding these weeds cannot be accepted. However, the cooperation of all citizens is solicited in the elimination of all nuisance weeds. The City of Vaughan now bans the use of chemicals to destroy weeds or weed seeds.
