THE STUDY

The City of Vaughan is undertaking a comprehensive study of its urban water infrastructure, including water, wastewater and stormwater systems, to support growth while emphasizing environmental sustainability and resiliency. The study will document existing problems and opportunities, consider and evaluate solutions and identified preferred water, wastewater and stormwater servicing strategies.

The Integrated Urban Water Plan study will evaluate servicing plans for current and future developments and identify alternative solutions and sustainability initiatives. The study will also integrate current sustainability, resiliency and climate change adaptation/mitigation initiatives identified in Green Directions Vaughan and the Official Plan Review.



THE PROCESS

The Integrated Urban Water Plan Environmental Assessment is being conducted in accordance with the Master Planning process (Approach #2) outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) guidelines (October 2000, amended 2007, 2011 and 2015). This approach involves the preparation of a Master Plan document at the conclusion of Phase One and Phase Two of the Class EA process.

The City values the voice of the public and is dedicated to having constructive decision-making dialogue with citizens, businesses and stakeholders that is open, transparent, accessible and inclusive.

Consultation with citizens is a key component of the study and is part of this EA process. The first of two Public Information Centres will be virtual, and it will provide an overview of what the Integrated Urban Water Plan is about and it will review existing conditions and identify opportunities, constraints and preliminary alternative solutions for the City's urban water infrastructure which includes water, wastewater and stormwater systems.

The virtual Public Information Centre will be available at vaughan.ca/UrbanWaterPlan from **Jan. 27 to Feb. 28**. The session will consist of a self-guided presentation followed by a short survey.
