Planning Underway for Improvements

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements on Bruce Street at Highway 7, including watermain replacement and rehabilitation. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Construction is expected to start in spring 2023.

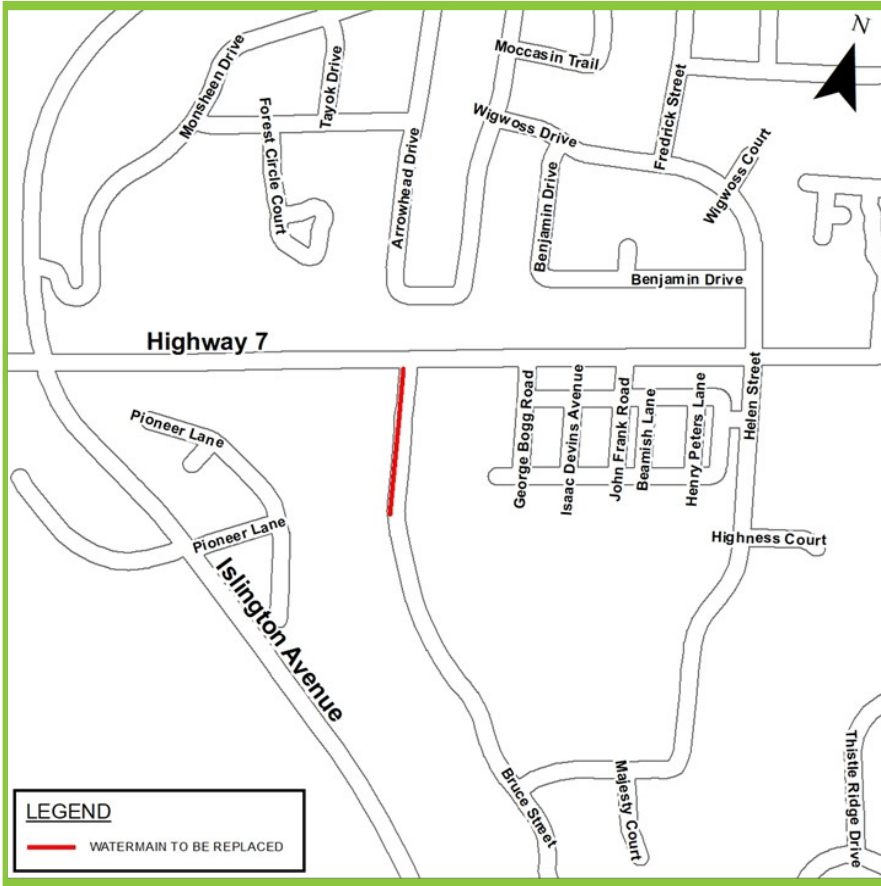
Construction Scope

Construction will include the replacement or rehabilitation of the existing watermains as identified in the areas of the red line on the enclosed map. The existing watermains are approaching the end of their effective service life and as a result, these metallic watermains are susceptible to cracks and corrosion which may lead to watermain breaks and service interruptions.

Field Investigation Work

In spring 2022, City-retained consultants will be undertaking investigation activities for the project which include topographic and/or legal surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation works.

All roads in the project area will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out by the consultant, under the direction of the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.
