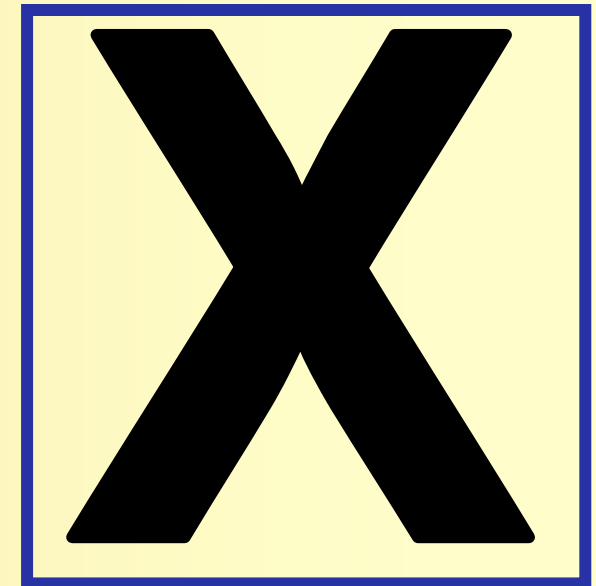

WHO CAN VOTE?

You can vote if you are...

- A Canadian citizen
- At least 18 years old
- A resident of Vaughan
- A non-resident who lives outside of Vaughan but who is, or whose spouse is, an owner or a tenant of land in Vaughan

1 candidate for Mayor

3 candidates for Local & Regional Councillor

1 candidate for Ward Councillor

1 candidate for School Trustee

HOW TO VOTE

An Election Official will hand you a ballot and a secrecy folder

Go behind the voting screen to vote

Mark the ballot with an "X" in the box like this, with the pen provided

Place your marked ballot inside the secrecy folder

Go to the voting machine where your ballot will be inserted and safely recorded.

ID WILL BE REQUIRED

Whether you choose to vote at the advance polls or on Election Day, you must present proper identification. If you are...

On the Voter's list:

Photo ID (e.g. valid Driver's License) **OR**

You will be required to take a sworn declaration at the voting location.

Not on the Voter's list:

Photo ID **AND**

Proof of Vaughan residency (e.g. tax bill, credit card statement, utility bill. etc.) or proof of non-resident eligibility **AND**

Complete a form to have your name added to the Voters' list.
