

Emerald Ash Borer Information Session

The City of Vaughan Parks & Forestry Operations Department in partnership with the CFIA and York Region is hosting an **Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Public Information Session**. The initial outbreak in Canada was detected in Windsor in 2002. The first positive EAB infested tree was detected in the City of Vaughan in 2008. The EAB infestation is expected to impact all Ash trees (*Fraxinus* spp.) within Vaughan by 2020. This information session will provide residents with details on the City of Vaughan's strategy for dealing with this infestation, and includes a 25 minute presentation by Forestry staff. A panel of representatives from the City of Vaughan, York Region and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency will be available to answer questions during the question and answer period.
